Pending Projects:

1. Budget training materials and field development into costs
2. Update Jr. Sting registration form and process
3. Write out job descriptions and procedures for the Board operation

Treasurer's Report:

- \$5,727.19 in account
- Registration fee will likely be increased to \$200 in total; the fee has been \$185 for five years
 - A vote for the increase in registration will occur at the next board meeting; John will present the budget at the next meeting
 - Approximately a \$5 fee per registration is paid to the Gillam Grant. This will also need to increase as there are additional administrative fees with credit card handling, etc.
 - Sting is still the least expensive registration fee in the league
 - The registration fees also include the UK Mini Camp and two tournaments or sessions for player development
- Scholarship funds are available on an as needed basis. However, documentation of needs must be provided and parent needs to put in volunteer time. And the family needs to fundraise.
- Approximately \$200 will go toward fines

President's Report:

- RDYSL Meeting
 - In 2012 RDYSL is discussion adding second referee to the U16 Division 1.
 - There is still discussion regarding this because a second referee system is not recognized (its either a one ref or three ref system)
- Welcome Tammy Fuller as the newly formed U10 Girls coach!
- There has been a change to the amount of players a team can have for registering a team
 - For U12 and below there must be 9 or more players to register the team with RDYSL
 - For U13 there must be 11 or more players
- The call up rule may change
 - U15 can play U16, U17 or U19
 - Player must have player pass to play
 - If the called up player gets a red card they will have to sit out two games. For example, if a U16 player gets a red card when playing on a U17 team (that they were called up to play) the player will have to sit out for two U17 games
- The only person that can decide to cancel a game (no makeup game) is the General Director
- Water breaks: only happen above 90 degrees and high humidity
 - 3 minutes for water break; players can leave the field during the water break.
- There is discussion about "Silent Soccer Week" where parents are silent on the sideline except for positive cheering – no "parent coaching" from the sidelines. Coaches will only coach on the sidelines.
 - This is not something that is enforceable but league is hoping for good compliance.
- Model clubs will get funds back from RDYSL.
 - Last year Sting met the criteria to be a model club but did not meet it this year due to one red card.

Indoor Time

- Time secured at Salmon Creek
 - Sunday 7-9am; Tues-Thurs 7-10pm (unlikely to use Tues/Thurs time due to school sports)
 - Price remains the same at \$82 per hour (cheapest rate after this in Rochester area is \$150)
 - Total of 38 hours available
 - Scheduled to start Nov 7th-March 27th

- Jeff Maurer suggested using the indoor time by combining groups and having coaches teach different skills (especially on speed on agility)
 - John Prospero feels it would be helpful if there were more age appropriate groups are together but not all age groups. Also the Salmon Creek Facility is so small it's a challenge to combine all groups. However, John will work on speed and agility sessions could be set up.
